Handling and Storing: Avoid breathing vapor. Keep away from heat and flame. Use with adequate vetilation. Do not puncture or incinerate containers. Do not expose to direct sunlight or store at temperatures above 130F (54C). Store as Level 2 Aerosol (NFPA 30B).
